# MULTI-CULTURAL TIMEBANKS

- I. How do you connect people?
  - a. I need \_\_\_\_\_
    - i. TimeBanks can connect
    - ii. Afterward people take over the reins themselves
  - b. TimeBank as a bridge to create interesting relationship that would not have existed otherwise
    - i. TimeBanking as a tool of empowerment
  - c. Create common interests
- II. Find leaders and they will connect communities
  - a. Who is a community leader?
    - i. Send introduction email/phone call
    - ii. Meet: be humble and listen
    - iii. Follow through accordingly
- III. Common question: Why are you going to others? That's what family is for!
  - a. You create message for the community– TBs can be complementary
- IV. Communities often divided
  - a. Lack of integration
  - b. Focus on humanity vs. race
  - c. Find strengths
- V. Cultural competency
  - a. Example: Who owns restaurants?
    - i. They are leaders
  - b. Go through back room
    - i. They are leaders
